

Just Different – In conjunction with Anti-Bulling week, ,It was lovely to welcome Helen Hewson from Just Different who spoke to our Year 3 & 4 pupils. Helen was born with cerebral palsy; this means the muscles in her body do not always do what her brain tells them to do. She uses a speech synthesiser and an electric wheelchair. Helen got her first wheelchair at the age of 6 years old. Helen enjoys doing things that give her a purpose in life. She taught the children that everyone is different and should be treated equally.
