

Fairtrade Fortnight – Fairtrade Fortnight is taking place between 24th February and 8th March. This year's theme is all about cocoa. The children will have the opportunity to find out more about the lives of cocoa farmers and the challenges they face in places such as West Africa, including Sierra Leone. The Fairtrade Prefects will be introducing this to the school in an assembly after half term and activities will be running in classrooms throughout the fortnight.

Ash Wednesday Eucharist – We are having our Ash Wednesday service on **Wednesday 26th February at 9am**. If you would like to join us for this then everyone is welcome. Last year Father Paul modelled the ash crosses on the children's heads and this year the children will be given the opportunity to have an ash cross at the end of the service.

Swimming Gala – Well done to our amazing swimming teams, **Sam A, Freya C, Mae E, Daisy H, Chene du P, Jessie N, Callum T, Emily E, Rachel L and Albert G**, they all swam really well and worked fantastically as a team. Full results and certificates will be sent to the school in due course.



World Book Day - Thursday 5th March. We are celebrating this to raise awareness of the importance of reading and to develop children's love of books. We are inviting the children to dress up as a book character of their choice and we would like them to bring in a favourite book to share with someone else (this does not need to link to their costume).



Steining Book Shop will be visiting the school on **Friday 13th March** from 2pm for the children. The parents are invited to look at the books in the school hall from 3pm. As a school, we do get commission from the sale of these books, which in turn allows us to purchase new books for our library. The children will be receiving a £1.00 book voucher, which can be used towards a book of their choice. Books start from £1.00 and the children will receive their vouchers on the day.

Henry Adams are running a competition for 'World Book Day' that will be announced in an assembly after half term, details will also be put in the Newsletter after this time.

Giles Paley-Phillips - We will also be welcoming the author Giles Paley-Phillips who has written titles such as 'The Fearsome Beastie, Tamara Small and the Monsters Ball, Princess Stay Awake, Superchimp, Things You Never Knew About Santa Clause and Things You Never Knew About Dinosaurs. Giles will be joining us in the morning and will work with the KS1 classes and holding a KS2 assembly.

INSET Day – Friday 14th Feb – Just a reminder that we do have an INSET day next Friday. The staff will be in school looking at the curriculum, 'deeper diving' into curriculum area to ensure the coverage in learning is deep and purposeful and looking at how we can ensure that the children are knowing more, remembering more and being able to do more. We will also be developing our subject policies to reflect the entitlement of the children.

Peace Posters – We are entering the Lions 'Peace Poster' competition. The theme is Peace around the world. The teachers will be sending home further details. We normally win lots of the prizes.

Preparing for Communion – There is a letter coming home about 'Preparing for Communion'. If your child attends a church regularly and is baptised and you want your child to receive communion in our school Eucharist, then please look out for the letter.

Family Support Work – Please note that the session on the **11th February has been cancelled** and will now take place on the **17th February from 1.30pm – 3.30pm** in the Pulborough Youth Centre.

Little Explorers – This week the children have been enjoying the 'baby clinic' role-play area where they have been caring for the babies, bathing them and making up bottles filling and emptying them. They have also been measuring each other to see who is the tallest / smallest. We have started a display of the children as babies, which they love to look at.



On Tuesday, we welcomed 'Little Science Stars Class' which is an interactive session developed and run by qualified teachers. The children get opportunities to learn by mixing, measuring, pouring and experimenting. The theme this time was rainbows and the children had great fun with the experiments as well as singing and dancing. At Forest School this week the children had opportunities to make hedgehogs using pinecones and clay, and made Robins by drilling holes in the wood for its feet, developing hand eye coordination, hammering tees into vegetables and made s'mores on the campfire, as well as playing on the tyre swing and slack line.


