PE Kit – PE kit is so important at this time with getting children outside and moving. PE kit must be school kit **white T-shirt**, (not a coloured T-shirt - this is only for sports day) **blue shorts and then trainers or plimsolls**. P.E kits **must** be taken home to be washed on Friday and please return it on Monday. It is part of the curriculum and so the children must participate. Earrings cannot be warn or taped up during P.E lessons, the child **must** be able to remove their own earrings, ideally earrings would not be warn to school on the days they have P.E.

COVID 19 – As part of locality discussions, it has been mentioned that there has been a case where a parent gave a child calpol to ensure they could come in to school when they were exhibiting a very high temperature. This is very selfish and puts the children, staff and parents at risk. If your child requires calpol because of a high temperature or any other symptom associated with COVID 19 then the child MUST NOT come to school.
