Football match report - The Year 6 boys' football team travelled to



That resulted in a joint third place finish in the group and onto the seventh place play-off match against Leechpool B. The boys ran out convincing winners in a 4-0 success with goals

All children that enter will receive a personal letter of thanks from Mr Griffith and their art will be displayed in the online gallery on his website. Designs should be returned to the school office by **Wednesday 8th November** and need to include your child's name, year group and school name on the back.
