First Aid – Year 5 were given the opportunity to learn some lifesaving skills this week. A representative from Little Life Savers came to the school and showed the children how to perform CPR, how to place someone in the recovery position and how to perform the Heimlich manoeuvre which can save someone from choking.



It was amazing to hear that following training given to children in other schools they have had at least three lives saved by children administering the Heimlich manoeuvre safely and with success.

Please note that the Heimlich manoeuvre and CPR should never be practised by the children on their friends for fun.







Seaford College – Seaford College visited our school this week on a 'Community Day'. They came armed with paintbrushes and paint and have reinvigorated our fences around the swimming pool. Thank you to them for making a difference to our school.

Roman Workshop – NZ and Ireland class have the privilege of the Novium Museum, Chichester this week. They bought in a selection of Roman artefacts to share with us. The children were lucky enough to try on a Roman helmet and Roman armour and we looked at a replica Roman sword.
