We will also be writing alternative endings to Roald Dahl's 'The Enormous Crocodile'. <b>2<sup>nd</sup> half term:</b> We will be writing tourist information leaflets about important cities in the UK. We will then be writing a narrative story based on a video about a city.		<b>Maths -</b> <b>1<sup>st</sup> half term:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Multiplication and Division</li><li>• Length and Perimeter</li></ul> <b>2<sup>nd</sup> half term:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Fractions</li><li>• Mass and Capacity</li></ul>		<b>Science -</b> <b>1<sup>st</sup> half term:</b> We will be continuing our learning about 'Forces and Magnets'. This will then be followed by 'Animals including Humans' <b>2<sup>nd</sup> half term:</b> In the second half term, we will be learning about 'Light'. We will identify light sources and learn about shadows.	
<b>PE -</b> <b>1<sup>st</sup> half term:</b> We will be participating in gymnastics in the hall every <b>Tuesday</b> . Mrs Burbidge will take the children for volleyball on a <b>Friday</b> morning. <b>2<sup>nd</sup> half term:</b> Mrs Burbidge will be teaching tennis, with a focus on hitting and striking with accuracy and distance.		<b>Spanish -</b> The children will be taught Spanish each week by Miss Bell. They will be learning a range of colours in Spanish, and then talking about pets. They will learn how to say we have or don't have particular animals, and will begin to use the colours we have learned to describe them.		<b>RHE -</b> <b>1<sup>st</sup> half term:</b> We will be learning about achievements and setting goals. <b>2<sup>nd</sup> half term:</b> We will be celebrating diversity. Please note that all RHE lessons follow our curriculum and are age-appropriate.	
<b>Geography -</b> <b>1<sup>st</sup> half term:</b> We will be exploring human geography and looking at trading in more detail. <b>2<sup>nd</sup> half term:</b> We will start our topic 'Urban Pioneers' giving us an insight into what life is like in different cities around the world.			<b>Art -</b> <b>1<sup>st</sup> half term -</b> We will be learning about feathers. We are also very lucky to have a visit booked with local artist, Dominique Salm.		<b>D&amp;T -</b> <b>2<sup>nd</sup> half term -</b> We will be making an electronic key.
<b>RE -</b> <b>1<sup>st</sup> half term:</b> We will be learning about Gospel. <b>2<sup>nd</sup> half term:</b> We will be looking into Salvation and the Easter Story.		<b>Music -</b> <b>1<sup>st</sup> half term:</b> We will be learning the song 'Three little birds'. <b>2<sup>nd</sup> half term:</b> We will be learning a song called 'The Dragon Song'.		<b>Computing -</b> <b>1<sup>st</sup> half term:</b> We will be exploring spreadsheets. <b>2<sup>nd</sup> half term:</b> We will be learning how to touch type.
