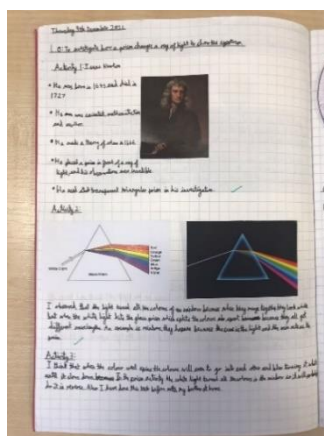
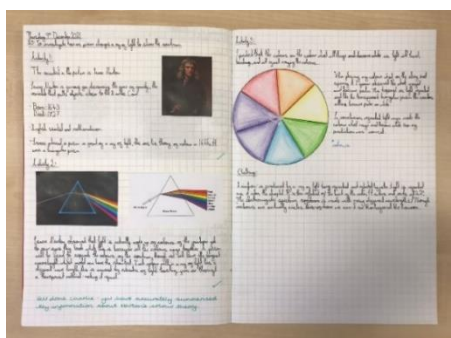
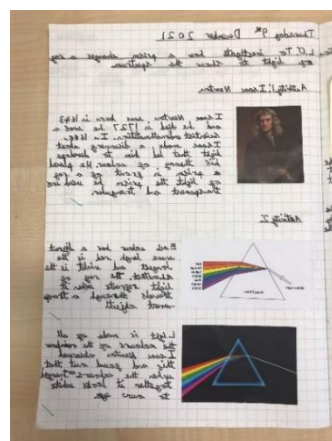
Well done to **Max H (Ind)** for Man of the match, he is a great goalie!
