That way they will not be behind their peers when they return after absence.

Homework is being shared with the whole class and feedback is being given in school. You will not get written feedback for a pieces of work submitted as it is verbal in the class as it is proved this is the best way to acknowledge the children's efforts and move their learning on.

Communication with teachers – Please could I remind parents that teachers will be teaching all day and therefore will not be replying to emails all the time the children are in class. If you need an immediate message to get to the teacher then please contact the office and they will pass messages on.

Closing date: Friday 16th October 2020




