Re: September 2021

We hope you had a great summer and are coming back to school having created some memories. We have been working hard in school to ensure that we are ready to welcome the children back and we are excited to hear what they have got up to over the holidays. The staff and Governors have received their safeguarding training on Thursday 2nd September, the staff have been receiving training in the importance of Oracy and Drama, updated their phonics and spelling knowledge ready for our start back.

On the front page of the school website is a copy of our risk assessment for returning, (DFE Corona Virus Risk Assessment Plan 6th September 2021).

We understand that things have changed but the virus has not gone anywhere and we are prioritising keeping the school open for teaching and learning and keeping staff and children safe. We will continue to take some precautions to try to minimise the spread of the virus, especially as it seems that numbers are likely to rise over the coming weeks.

As a minimum, we will: ● retain zones within the school ● retain our increased cleaning programme ● encourage good hand hygiene (regular hand washing or sanitising) ● continue to ventilate classrooms as well as possible ● limit the sharing of resources as far as possible ● encourage parents to wear a mask for drop off and collection

In terms of drop off and collection we will run in the same way until October half term and then if things are OK, then we will go to two staggered times. This is due to the need for the children to sanitise and enter school in a distanced fashion.

We ask that children bring a rucksack that contains their PE kit (ensure they have long PE bottoms and a jumper for outdoor PE as the uniform policy), drink bottle, snack and lunchbox (if needed). **We would like your child to bring their own pencil case for their new class but there is no rush to provide this but when it is convenient then please send it in.**

Early Birds starts on **Tuesday 7th September** and if your child is attending Early Birds then they must be at the side gate at **8am**. They will be collected by Mrs Parsons and Mrs Metaliaj.

Roosters after school club will start on **Tuesday 7th September** and will be run by Ms Elliott and Mrs Haley-Chattaway.

COVID-19 - If your child is unwell with a new and persistent cough or a high temperature, or has a loss of or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia) then they must stay at home, self-isolate and get a test.

If anyone in the school becomes unwell with a new and persistent cough or a high temperature, or has a loss of or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia), they will be sent home and advised to follow [guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus \(COVID-19\) infection](#). The guidance sets out that they should self-isolate for at least 10 days and should [arrange to have a test](#) to see if they have coronavirus (COVID-19). Other members of their household (including any siblings) should self-isolate for 10 days from the day after the individual tested positive.
