Read with an adult at home, at least three times a week. Practise sounding and blending short words.

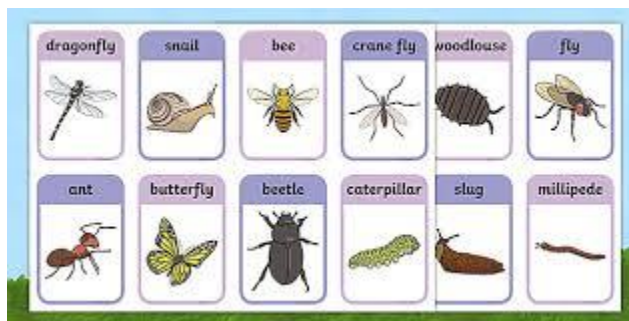
Geography
