## Hot School Meals - Order the meal your child would like.

Chartwells are bringing in a new system that allows you to choose which meal your child would like to eat each day. This is for all children throughout the school, from Reception through to Year 6, those entitled to free school meals and those who pay for a meal.



You will have received a letter from ParentPay with all your log-in details and details of how the system will work. The School Office will have very limited access to the system, so it is very important that if you wish your child to have a hot school meal in school, no matter which class they are in, you have to access this system and order their meal.


